<p><b>English</b></p> <p>Write your teacher a persuasive letter, with the purpose of persuading them to let you have your chosen reward at the end of half term. Make sure you use a range of persuasive techniques (and that the reward is realistic).</p>	<p><b>Guided reading</b></p> <p>Create a Viking Vocabulary Booklet for the half term. Add all the new words you have learnt in school or researched yourself.</p>	<p><b>Guided reading</b></p> <p>Create a comic strip for Viking boy summarising the story at each main event.  Ask your teacher for a comic strip template.</p>	<p><b>Reading for pleasure</b></p> <p>Enjoy reading your favourite book - take a photo of you reading it in the most 'interesting' place.</p>
<p><b>Project</b></p> <p>Create a fact file of a Viking. Include a labelled drawing of a Viking and some facts.. E.g. lifestyle, appearance, behaviours.</p>	<p><b>Project</b></p> <p>Make your own Viking boat - does it float? Why/why not?  How is this similar/different to traditional Viking boats?</p>	<p><b>Project</b></p> <p>Compare life in the Viking days to current life - you can present this however you wish. Make sure you comment on similarities and differences.</p>	<p><b>Music</b></p> <p>Make up a rap about Vikings - this can be based on an element of Vikings of your choice. Write the lyrics down in rhyming form or 5 extra house points for videoing yourself rapping it!</p>
<p><b>Maths</b></p> <p>Create a Viking themed times table game for your classmates to play.</p>	<p><b>Times tables</b></p> <p>Keep practising your times tables for your weekly test.  Keep going on TTRS!</p>	<p><b>DT</b></p> <p>Can you design your own viking helmet?  What materials would you use and why?</p>	<p><b>Science</b></p> <p>Create a list of items in your house that can cause an irreversible change.  Were any of these items used in the Viking era?</p>
