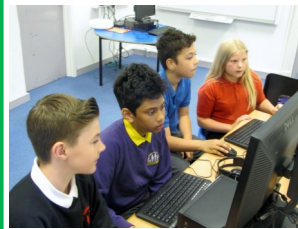
Mayor Making

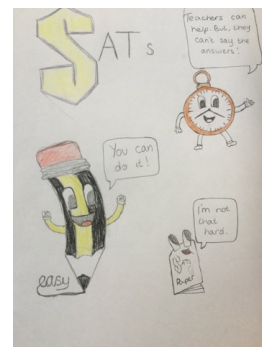
