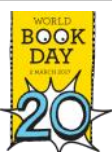

From 1st March, 2W will have their swimming lessons.

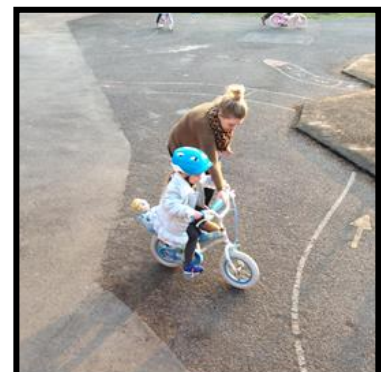


Year 2 having great fun on the Dance mats trying to follow the leader and also help their partner.

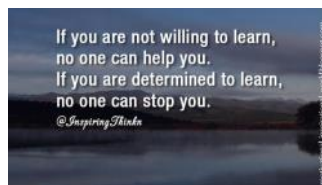
