Over **400** children received **Reading at Home 'dojo' rewards** this term, **137** of these children have **read more than 5 times a week over the last 6 weeks.** **93%** of our children logged on to **Sum Dog** this term to support their maths learning. **Well done and thank you for encouraging your children.**

Thank you for your help with this.

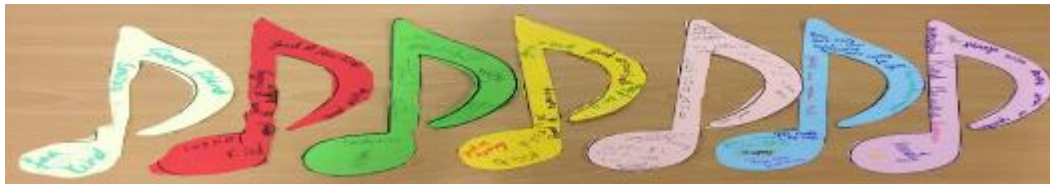


## Article 28

## Dance and Music

**Year 1** spent the term developing spatial awareness and exploring still, strong shapes with a change in levels. Towards the end of the term, we also introduced travelling pathways and 'mirroring' each other's shapes. The curriculum link for the term was 'All About Me' with the groups thinking about their own special powers and how they could show their 'power pose' when they woke in the morning.

**Year 2** have spent most of the term creating the 'Gruffalo' video which was a collaboration of sound effects of the Gruffalo creatures that they created in their music lessons. The technical details included creating strong, still woodland creature shapes that included balance, travelling pathways with a change of levels and exploring the words 'stroll', 'creep', 'over', 'under' and 'around'.

**Year 4C** Curriculum link was the Tudors where they created warm up games with hoops inspired by how Tudor children played, explored canon, gesture & patterns based on a video that showed how they learnt in class, and then also learnt an original Tudor dance that included gestures, jumps, travelling pathways & canons.



**15 Year 6** children sang festive songs for the Christmas Dinner at **Carnival House**. The children sang brilliantly and everyone was very impressed. They have even invited us on a tour of a cruise ship in the new year! We will be also visiting Rotary House to sing to the residents there. **Well done Year 6!**

## E-safety Advice Page

With Christmas just around the corner lots of our children may have the latest games consoles, tablets and smartphones on their lists for Santa. With this in mind it is worth remembering that whilst these can be fantastic fun for the children and also have a positive impact on their learning, if not used carefully they can also have a negative impact on your child's mental health and wellbeing. Recent studies have shown that this can affect children as young as two years old. **Research showed that those children who were frequently exposed to "screen time" were likely to lose their temper more easily and lose their sense of curiosity.**

With this in mind it is worth considering setting up the parental controls on any new and existing devices that your children may access in order to limit the amount of time they can spend online and to help keep them safe at all times.

### What are parental controls?

Parental controls are software and tools which you can install on phones or tablets, games consoles or laptops – and even your home broadband.

You can also use them to help you block or filter the content your child sees when searching online.

Parental controls are also available to help you to:

- *plan what time of day your child can go online and how long for*
- *stop them from downloading apps they're too young for*
- *manage the content different members of the family can see.*

**So whatever your child is doing online, there's a way that you can help keep them safe.**

It may sound daunting at first trying to keep up to date with all the latest apps, games consoles or entertainment channels and ensuring that your child is using them safely. **Most devices and apps have parental controls that can be setup and protected using a password to prevent your child accessing unsuitable material.** It is important that you use a password that your child or anybody else is not able to easily guess. It should ideally be something that is easy for you to remember but a mixture of upper and lowercase letters, numbers and characters such as @!<>#\$

A good place to start is to try googling **Saferinternet.org** and **internetmatters.org** or type the links below directly into an internet browser.

These two sites have some simple easy to follow step by step guides to configuring parental controls on some of the most popular apps, games consoles and websites. Don't forget, some TV channels freely available on the internet through BBC iplayer and ITV Hub may also contain unsuitable material, these can all be configured to require passwords to access age restricted material.

Finally, many of you may have heard of **Fortnite** - the latest online game that all the children are keen to play. The below link will enable you to register for a free webinar which aims to offer parents free tips and privacy advice to help keep your children safe whilst playing the game.
