Place raisins in a fizzy drink. What happens? Why do you think this is?	Make your own rock candy using sugar.	Investigate what happens when you mix baking soda with vinegar.	What happens when you float skittles in a dish of warm water?
Cover an ice cube in salt and another one in sugar. Have another uncovered ice cube. What do you notice about the time they take to melt?
