

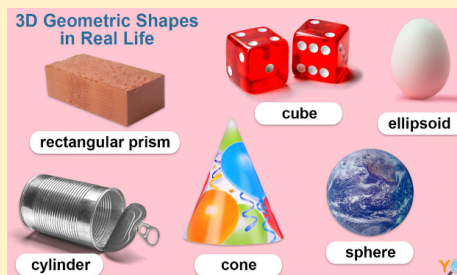
# Year 2 Homework Grid

## English

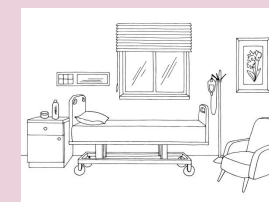
Can you find examples of things that are different from your life as a child to your grown-up when they were younger?
