Each week, please complete one of the activities from the grid below. Don't forget to stick your work into your homework books. Bring your homework book in every Monday for your teacher to have a look at your work.

This terms topic is: Furious Pharaohs

Practise your times tables (2x,5x, 10x, 4x and associated division facts) by playing a game with someone in your house. Write the tables down if you need to before starting! Ask your partner to throw a small teddy to you and ask a times table question, eg 6x2. You need to give the answer and throw the teddy back to your partner.	Research female pharaohs from Ancient Egypt. How many can you find out about and what can you tell me about them? When the Ancient Egyptians mummified a body, they put some of the organs into canopic jars. Design your own jar - which God are you going to show on your jar? Listen to some Egyptian music on youtube. What instruments can you hear? What does it make you think of?	Look at this website, and sketch the sphinx. Make a poster or leaflet showing what you have found out.
