The children have experienced a wide range of trips and experiences linked to the curriculum, including visits to the London Eye, Harry Potter Studio tours, The Living Rainforest, Itchen Valley Country Park, Queen Elizabeth Country Park, Lepe Country Park and the Guildhall (where children performed with the Bournemouth Symphony Orchestra). We really appreciate your support towards these trips and experiences which enrich the children's lives.

We are so proud of our sporting achievements this year which continue to go from strength to strength. As a result of our commitment, engagement and participation in competitive sport, we have just been awarded 'the School Games Gold' award. We would also like to congratulate our football team who came second in the whole of Southampton- what a great achievement! Thank you to all of you who helped to make the sports day events so fabulous; a good time was had by all.

Our school improvement focus this year has aimed to increase the proportion of children achieving the Greater Depth Standard in writing and are proud to say that we have been successful: 20% of our Year 6 children achieving this standard (a 10% increase). We are also very pleased to say that the proportion of our Year 6 children achieving the expected standard in writing, reading and maths is above the national again for the third year in a row.

Thank you for all your support this year, we really appreciate this, especially all your our fabulous PTA 'Friends of Shirley Warren'. They have raised over £1700 towards refurbishing our Year R playground. Fundraising events this year have included, Bingo (my favourite), discos, Bake Off, film nights and the Summer Fayre. This means we now have raised a total of **£1900**.

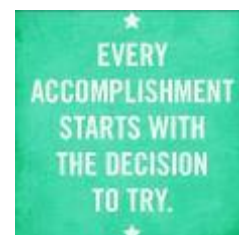

Shirley Warren to go CASHLESS in October

From **25th October 2019**, any payments to be made to school can **only be made online**. This means that dinners, trips, clubs, Breakfast Club, After School Club, Holiday Club, Nursery and Pre-Nursery will all now be paid for **online**. We are letting you know now to give you plenty of time to set up your online account if you haven't got one already. We will be sending letters home with your password to those who don't have an account. We will **not** have the facility to take cash after this date.

It will be so much easier for everyone to not have to hunt for cash on a regular basis. You will also be able to track payments on your account too.



New Gate Entry System

We thank you for your patience since the installation of our new gate entry system. The gates are **open** at the **beginning** and **end** of the school day but between the hours of **9.15am and 2.30pm** you will have to **press the intercom** to get in and out of the school playground. This is all part of our safeguarding. The gate by Chestnut House car park will be locked between these hours so to enter the school you must use the main gate by the Nursery.

If your child is not coming to school...

Please phone the school office **before 9am** if your child is not coming to school and let us know the reason why. If we have not heard from you, you will either receive a text or a call from the admin team to find out where your child is. This is an important part of our safeguarding procedures.

Is my child too ill to come to school?

We are sure it will help you decide whether or not you should send your child to school. Please remember that if your child has **sickness or diarrhoea**, they need to be **clear** of this for **48 hours** before returning to school. Data Collection Sheets

In September, we will be sending out Data Collection Sheets to everyone. Please make sure this is returned to school straight away. It is so important for us to have the correct contact information, especially if your child is unwell. It can be very distressing if your child is poorly and your number is unobtainable. Thank you.



Flu Immunisation

In September, parents of children in Years R – 6 will receive notification of Flu Immunisation in school. You will receive an 'Information for Parents' leaflet and a consent form which you will need to complete and return to the school. Some of your children would have received the nasal vaccination last year, however the NHS have extended the service and made the vaccination accessible to other year groups this year. Please take up this offer from the NHS.

Lost Property

We continue to gain a **vast** amount of unclaimed, unnamed school uniform. If **items are named** they can be returned to the child instantly. Thank you for your help with this.

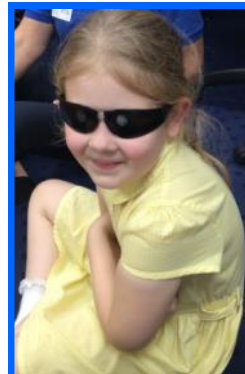

With the summer holidays fast approaching and the temptation of using electronic devices to fill the time - take a look at **10 top tips from internetmatters.org to help you keep your child's screen time under control.**

1. Set a **good example** with your own device use.
2. Have discussions **about the risks** that they may face based on their online activities.
3. Put in place a **family agreement** and agree an appropriate length of time they can use their device.
4. Help them **build critical thinking** to understand that some features on platforms are designed to keep you watching or playing.
5. Encourage them to **switch off auto-play** on platform to remove the temptation to binge on programmes.
6. Use tech tools and parental control to **manage the time** they spend online and the apps they use.
7. Get the whole family to unplug and **create 'screen free' zones** at home.
8. Together find apps, site and games that will help children explore their passions and **make screen time active.**
9. For younger children find ways to **combine touch screen use with creative and active play.**
10. Encourage children to **self-regulate the time they spend online** and the activity they do to ensure they are having a positive impact on their wellbeing.

Now may also be a good time to **check that your parental controls are set correctly** on your electronic devices and within popular apps.
