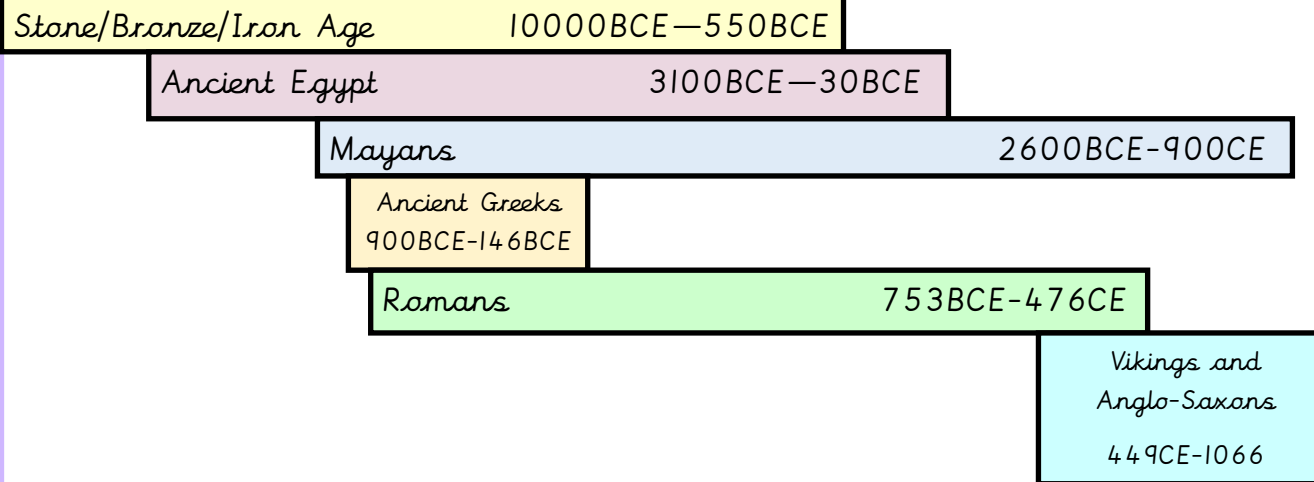

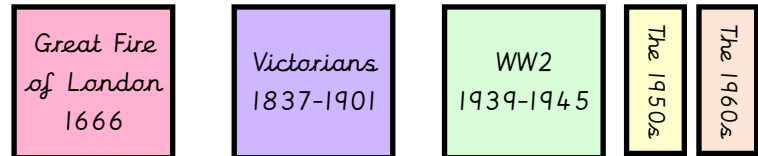

Titanic



Key Facts

The Titanic was a British passenger liner that set off from Southampton on 12th April 1912.
It was measured over 882 feet long and 175 feet high
The ship was built by the White Star Line, a prominent shipping company of the time .
The ship carried over 2,200 passengers and crew on its maiden voyage .
Over 1,500 people died in the disaster, mainly due to the lack of lifeboats and the cold temperature of the water.
The Titanic was a British passenger liner that sank in the North Atlantic Ocean on April 15, 1912,.
The Titanic was built at the Harland and Wolff shipyard in Belfast, Northern Ireland.
The wreck of the Titanic was discovered in 1985 .

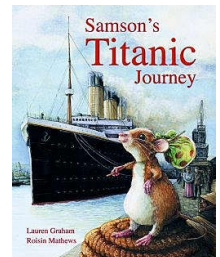



<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 31st March 1909—The building of the Titanic started 12th April 1912— the Titanic set sail from Southampton on its journey to New York 11:40pm 14th April 1912— The Titanic hit a iceberg 12:30am 15th April 1912- Lifeboats were lowered 2:17am 15th April 1912— The Titanic split into 2 parts 2:24 am 15th April 1912- The Titanic hit the ocean floor 4:10am 15th April 1912— Passengers were rescued by Carpathia- a sailing ship that passed by.
