## Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back and hello to our new families! We hope you had a lovely Summer. We would like to inform you that our new theme this half term is 'Nursery Rhymes' The children will be learning different nursery rhymes each week. We will also be planning activities around all the different nursery rhymes.

# Communication & Language

To develop communication and language skills, the children will be taking part in Circle Time on a daily basis: Talking about what the children did over the Summer and welcoming new friends into Pre-nursery. We will be encouraging the children to use their words, as well learning Makaton signs to help them communicate.

# Physical Development

To develop the children's physical skills, they will taking part in tummy time on a regular basis which is also a great activity for you to do at home. We are also going to be pouring water down the drain pipes to wash Incy Wincy out.

# Personal, Social & Emotional Development

We are going to be working on our personal, social and emotional skills this term helping the children to seek out others to share their experiences. The children will wok on their turn taking and sharing skills; please encourage sharing opportunities at home and give lots of praise.

# Understanding the World

This half term we are going to be looking at our Unique Child booklets, sharing the pictures of our families with our friends. We also have our home corner set up, this allows the children to engage in pretend play along side the other children.

# Literacy

Every week we have a song of the week which we will send out to you, please encourage your child to sing this with you at home. Alongside this we are introducing a book a fortnight, this is where we will choose a story to read with the children at story time for two weeks. The children will get to learn, act out and retell the story. You can find out what story we are reading by looking at our weekly planning which is displayed on our parents board.





# Mathematics

To develop the children's maths skills we are going to be looking at the different sizes of Baa, Baa Black sheep, filling three bags full of wool and counting the legs on Incy Wincy Spider. During our circle time we will be playing a Humpty Dumpty puzzle game, the children will need to fit the different size pieces together to put Humpty Dumpty back together again.

# Expressive Arts & Design

Once a week we have a music session with Helen; Helen will be teaching us different nursery rhymes every week.

We will be getting very creative this half term. We are going to be making twinkle stars using the glue and glitter, A wall for Humpty Dumpty and Incy Wincy Spiders out of clay.

Read, Read, Read!

### Top tips for sharing books with your child.

- Find a quiet place. Turn off the TV or radio so there are no distractions.
- As well as reading the story, talk about the pictures.
- Give your child time to respond to your questions.
- It's good to share your favourite stories again and again. Repetition helps children to understand and remember the language they hear.

### Top tips for sharing songs and rhymes with your child.

- Your voice is your baby's favourite music- so sing to them, even if you don't like your own voice.
- Make rhymes fun make up actions that your child can follow, add in your child's name or make props for the rhymes.
